Dear Mr. President:

We are writing on behalf of our North Korea Freedom Coalition and our city and country coordinators around the world to express our heartfelt thanks to you for your efforts to try to save the lives of North Korean refugees. We wanted to share with you that today in 20 countries around the world letters appealing to Xi Jinping to stop the illegal and inhuman repatriation of North Korean refugees were delivered to the Chinese Embassies and consulates in 49 cities. In some cities, prayer vigils, demonstrations, and other protests -- the largest was in Seoul -- were also held. Together, everyone called for the end of China's brutal policy and for the refugees to be allowed safe passage to South Korea.

This coordinated action, Save North Korean Refugees Day, is organized by the North Korea Freedom Coalition each year to show China that the international community is aware of their heinous actions and so that these refugees know that the world is aware of their plight. We were all heartbroken to learn of the most recent executions of two North Korean women who dreamed of living in freedom in South Korea after helping forty-one others achieve that dream. As you know, September 24 is the date when the People's Republic of China signed the 1951 Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees and its 1967 Protocol, the very agreement it is violating! On this day when we remember the horrific actions by Xi, we also want to recognize there are world leaders like yourself who have worked to save the lives of North Koreans.

In the words of our Washington, D.C., coordinator, Pastor Star Lee, "South Korea, the United States, and the world will unite to protect North Korean refugees until the end." We pledge to do all we can and thank you again for your efforts.
